The Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART) has received funding from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) to provide commuter transportation options during the Business 40 reconstruction project. Beginning late fall, PART will be expanding the Route 17 Kernersville/Winston-Salem Express service to encourage more people to ride PART Express during the closure.

PART Express Route 17 that serves Kernersville to Winston-Salem will be enhanced to provide more options for commuters from Kernersville traveling to Downtown Winston-Salem, and Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center. The new Route 17 service will run Monday – Friday from 5:30am to 6:45pm with more service throughout the day, starting from a new Park & Ride at Kernersville Town Hall.
